Dress for the weather, bring your own water bottle and wear appropriate footwear. Gloves will be provided.

Directions

If arriving from the north, take 103rd St. to S. Doty Ave, go left (South) on Stony Island Ave. and proceed to the Big Marsh north side parking lot. The lot will be on your left after you cross the railroad tracks.

If arriving from the south, take Torrence Ave north to 122nd St, turn left onto 122nd and drive to Stony Island Ave. Turn right (north) on Stony Island Ave., pass by the main Big Marsh entrance and continue driving until you reach the Big Marsh north side parking lot, which will be on your right.
